- ❖ An emergency call button is also located to the left of the main entrance of the Ski Lodge
- ❖ Vehicles are permitted in designated areas only, during occupancy of the campground. **Renters must display this form on vehicle dashboard.**
- ❖ Alcoholic beverages are NOT permitted without an alcohol permit. Permits may be obtained from the Health and Environmental Safety Office **(724-738-2055)** from 8:30am to 4:00pm Monday-Friday. Permits must be applied for a minimum of two (2) weeks prior to date of campsite rental.
- ❖ Camp fires are permitted only in camp stoves or in fire rings provided. All fires must be extinguished prior to leaving or retiring for the night. Fires must not be left unattended nor allowed to grow large. Renters must provide their own fire wood.
- ❖ Occupancy of each camp site is limited to no more than four (4) persons, including a responsible individual 18 years or older.
- ❖ Users are responsible for maintaining and leaving the area in a clean and orderly fashion, at all times, and properly using all facilities and equipment provided.
- ❖ Pets are permitted but must be leashed and in control at all times. Pet litter must be removed and disposed of in the trash receptacles provided.
- ❖ Firearms and archery equipment are not permitted except if necessary for academic classes or sanctioned activities. All firearms must be registered with the University Police Office, (724) 738-3333.
- ❖ All laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the regulations of SRU must be adhered to.
- ❖ Violations of the rules and regulations or and misrepresentation by individuals or groups will warrant cancellation of camping and Ski Lodge privileges and / or possible legal action.
